Competition Rules

1. Eligibility:

- a) Closing date is 18 September 2010
- b) No late entry is permitted.
- c) Age is taken as at 31 August 2010
- d) Every competitor must be nominated by his/her own piano teacher to enter the competition.

2. Guidelines:

- a) Competitors are permitted to play in only one section
- b) Time limits must be strictly adhered to. Points will be deducted.
- c) All competitors are to register at reception no less than 15 minutes prior to the commencement of their section. Late arrivals will not be eligible to perform.
- d) Memorisation is compulsory.
- e) No video or sound recording of any performance is permitted.
- f) Copyright rules apply. Photocopied music is not permitted to be used by any competitor. Competitors who do so will be disqualified.

3. Adjudicators

- a) Copies of competitor's pieces must be lodged at reception on arrival. Photocopies will not be returned.
- b) There will be no communication between parents, competitors, guardian and teachers and adjudicators.
- c) The adjudicators' decisions will be final.
- d) Adjudication reports will be available on completion of each section at reception. No reports will be posted to competitors.

4. Competition Programme

After receipt of all entries, competitors will receive the programme by mail which will confirm the date and time of their sections. The adjudicators for each section will also be listed in the programme. The cost of the programme is \$3 and will be added to the entry fee.

Vivace Music would like to advise that audience seating is limited. Only 4 seats will be allocated per competitor. Entry cost for non-competitor is \$5 per ticket, and entry pass(es) will be posted to you together with the programme.
